

LACC Golf Committee Minutes

Tuesday, July 14, 2020

PRESENT: Mike Chuchel, Scott Devereaux, Art Broughton, Maggie Fleming, Steve Fleming, Bruce Gillies, Bob Haney, Bob Lambert, Will Rasmussen, Diane Rudgers

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order by Mike Chuchel, Chairman, at 2:30 p.m.

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA: A motion was made, seconded, and carried to approve the agenda.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES: A motion was made, seconded, and carried to approve the September 10, 2019 minutes.

CORRESPONDENCE: None

STAFF REPORTS:

- A) General Manager – Scott Devereaux welcomed new golf pro, Bob Haney, who opened the golf course this year on 5/1/20. Scott was pleased to report the golf course revenue is \$12,000 ahead of budget. Regarding the 2021 golf budget, he will be sending it out to all involved with submitting requested additions. Budget requested items to Scott by August 17, 2020. He also said the clubhouse building, which includes the golf shop, was disinfected during the brief closing last week. He is hoping to open the restaurant for take-out soon.
- B) Head Golf Professional – Bob Haney reported the Almanor Open golf tournament has been cancelled per his conversation with Bailey Creek. He is hoping to hold a Lovey Dovey event and is working on ideas for safe play and a social gathering afterward. He would like to offer weekly tournaments to increase play but is unable to so during this time. Despite that, the course is doing very well.
- C) Course Superintendent – Art Broughton reported they have a new drive on the golf course pump which handles variations in the PG&E voltage. They have eliminated the crab grass. They plan to plant new, colorful deciduous trees where some of the old trees had to be removed. Art also said his crew this year is “awesome.”

CLUB REPORTS:

- A) Men’s 18 – Bruce Gilles said all Men’s 18-hole events have been cancelled. They are still playing Sweeps on Wednesdays and Skins on Fridays. He said they may possibly play one Saturday a month to expose more people to their club and increase membership. They currently have 53 members. Their next meeting is scheduled for August 5, 2020 at 1:00 p.m.
- B) Will Rasmussen suggested we create a 1-page listing of all men’s and women’s golf groups complete with contact information, weekly play schedule, and cost to join. This will be included in new owner packets and will be made available where it may help promote our clubs. It will also be posted on our website. The presidents of each club are to email their information to Mike Chuchel (MikeChuchel@outlook.com) who will put it together for Scotts approval.

Will passed out a LACC Course Men's Handicap Data Summary that he has been compiling for several years. It ranks each hole handicap based on members hole-by-hole scores and is intended to assist NCGA in rating our course. He suggested the women's clubs start doing the same. He will provide the spreadsheet to plug the data into.

- C) Women's 18 – Maggie Fleming recognized Trudy Leete for keeping the group together this year. She has managed to accommodate both 18-hole and 9-hole players with her selection of games/sweeps. Through her efforts there are about a dozen players each week and everyone is enjoying it.
- D) Men's 9 – Bob Lambert reported the men's 9-hole group has not had any meetings yet.
- E) Women's 9 – Diane Rudgers said the 9-hole group is playing each week and they are going to start doing games/sweeps. Their first meeting will be Thursday, July 30, 2020.

OLD BUSINESS: The flashing red solar stop signs at hole 16, which were discussed last year, will be put into the 2021 budget. We will need two of them. The cost will be \$1,000 - \$1,500 each.

NEW BUSINESS: Art would like to remove the stand at hole 16 and replace it with a convex mirror. This will eliminate the need to rebuild the stand and will allow players to use the back tees again. The cost of the convex mirror is about \$200.
