Partners of the Plumas County Fire Safe Council reported that areas where under burning and hazardous fuel reduction were conducted, those areas had the most success in low-severity damage or no damage after the Dixie Fire. By doing a basic clean-up of your property, you are increasing the safety of our community. So, limb up your trees, rake up those pines needles (over 3 inch thick) and get rid of dead vegetation and tree limbs!
