

Status of Potential Projects

Lake Almanor Peninsula – \$356,774 2020 LNF Stevens funds requested to treat 269.6 acres

Greenhorn Ranch – \$191,087 2020 PNF Stevens funds requested to treat 195 acres of SPI & 37 acres of CSD land, submitted SPI lands as potential 2020 Governor’s Project

Grizzly Ranch –\$302,775 2020 PNF Stevens funds requested to treat 130 acres – *landowner unable to pay cost share*

Mohawk Valley – \$TBD request for 2021 PNF Stevens for implementation

Woodbridge - \$432,520 2021 PNF Stevens proposed for ~400 acres of treatment – *landowner unable to pay cost share* portions included in Gold Mountain CSD application to CAL FIRE

Indian Valley West – Indian Falls, Greenville, Crescent Mills public/private project

Chester Airport – 34 acres identified around airport for HFR

La Porte – landowner applications received. Community outreach in progress

Boyle Ravine – Audubon initiated project on AVCSD owned land and surrounding areas

Bucks Lake Highlands – 170 acre landowner application received

Eastern Plumas Health Care District – 30.08 acre application, included in Gold Mountain CSD application to CAL FIRE
