

Recreation Area Large Gatherings

Earlier this week, we confirmed with Plumas County that random large gatherings are still not allowed per the March 18 CPHA directive. We are being allowed, however, to hold such gatherings with certain protocol in place.

As such, the following guidelines must be followed for gatherings of 15-49 people on LACC common areas.

- Function must be pre-approved by the LACC Office
- Gathering must be held outdoors
- Gathering must have a host who is responsible for the gathering and enforcement of these guidelines
- The host must maintain a list of all attendees and their contact information. This list must be turned into the LACC Office after the function.
- Social distancing must be maintained at all times
- All attendees should frequently wash their hands and/or use hand sanitizer
- The use of shared items is prohibited (including shared food and pot lucks)
- All attendees must wear a face covering at all times during the function

The Board of Directors and management understand that a number of members are tired of restrictions and limitations on activities in the club. We believe, however, that one of the reasons we have been allowed to hold things like these gatherings is due to our efforts in adhering to past directives coming from the county and state.

We all are looking forward to the day, hopefully not too far in the future, when we will be able to return to a more normal operation. Thank you to all members for your efforts to date as well as your understanding during this pandemic.
